Y10 Assessments Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June – Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June

As communicated earlier in the year, during the period Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June until Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June, Y10 students will be having assessments in the majority of their subjects. Most assessments will take place during students' normal lessons; however, we will be conducting the following assessments under typical GCSE conditions, in order to prepare students for the experience next year:

**Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June AM    English Literature 2h 30**  
**Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June PM    Science 1h 15**  
**Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June AM    Maths 1h 30**

These will take place in the Sports Hall and Dance Studio and will conform to JCQ regulations, a copy of which can be found here: <https://www.heworthgrange.org/attachments/download.asp?file=387&type=pdf>  
Students will be reminded of these regulations during their advisories next week and will be given instructions to make sure they know what to do.

In addition, the students in these bands will have Science (Dual Award only) exams which will run until 3pm on the following days:

**10G:    Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June**  
**Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June**

**10H:    Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June**  
**Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June**

Should there be an urgent reason why your child cannot stay until 3pm on those days, please contact Mr Gates to discuss beforehand.

When students are not in these examinations they will be in lessons and are expected to attend school as normal. Attendance is vital over this period.

Following the marking and moderation of these assessments we will send you information about the progress of your child before the end of this term. For subjects where an assessment has not taken place, a "working at" grade will be calculated taking into account the coursework and module marks students have already achieved.
