Application of these methods is a feature of this area, allowing you to build a varied portfolio of compositional work using their DAW and apply it to variety of contexts.

Understand the recording studio environment and how to use it safely to produce and mix audio recordings. You will be encouraged to use your existing knowledge of a DAW, exploring how a recording studio can further enhance your recording and mixing process. Details of audio hardware will be covered, such as microphones, DI, audio interfaces, multitrack recorders and monitoring equipment. Additionally, you will gain knowledge of the recording techniques and processes used within the studio environment. Health and safety are features of this area ensuring that you are able to work safely within the recording studio.
