Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements made for the GCSE Results Day and to outline times for your child to collect their exam results. As you will be aware, GCSE results will be released on **Thursday 22nd August 2024**.

1. Students are invited into school to collect their results face-to-face at staggered times. Please arrive at school via Student Reception, adhering to the allocated times to ensure that the handout of results goes smoothly.
2. Times are allocated by surname as follows:

Surname A-G	9.30am-10.00am
Surname H-O	10.00am-10.30am
Surname P-Z	10.30am-11.00am

If any students arrive before their allocated time, they will be asked to wait.

3. If students are unable to collect their results in person, please email the Exams Officer hga-exams@consilium-at.com. Students will be asked to provide a letter, signed by the student, nominating a person to collect their results. The nominated person must produce photo identification to confirm they are permitted to collect - without this they will not be able to take the exam results.
4. If a student is unable to collect the results in person on the day, or nominate a person on their behalf, the results will be posted to their address via first class post on Thursday 22nd August 2024. Please ensure school have your most up-to-date address if you have recently moved.
5. On collection of the results there will be a short "destination" form to complete. This data is gathered to inform the Local Authority of intended destinations and is a **statutory requirement**. This also allows us to support any student that may not have a place for the start of Year 12. **Students must not leave without completing this form. The QR Code to access the digital form is in your exams pack. Please complete.**
6. If students have any queries regarding their Year 12 intended choices following their GCSE results, staff will be on hand to offer advice and guidance. Careers Education Lead, Mrs Bell, will be available in the Theatre along with representatives from Further Education.
7. Details about re-marks for exam papers are on the school website within the Key Information section.

We welcome students to take the opportunity to celebrate their achievements and will have a place for them to take photographs after they have received their results.

Results Day is also a good opportunity for students to return any remaining textbooks, revision guides, or uniform they may still have so there will be drop-off boxes at Student Reception.
