- To evaluate your mood board with focus on inspiration.

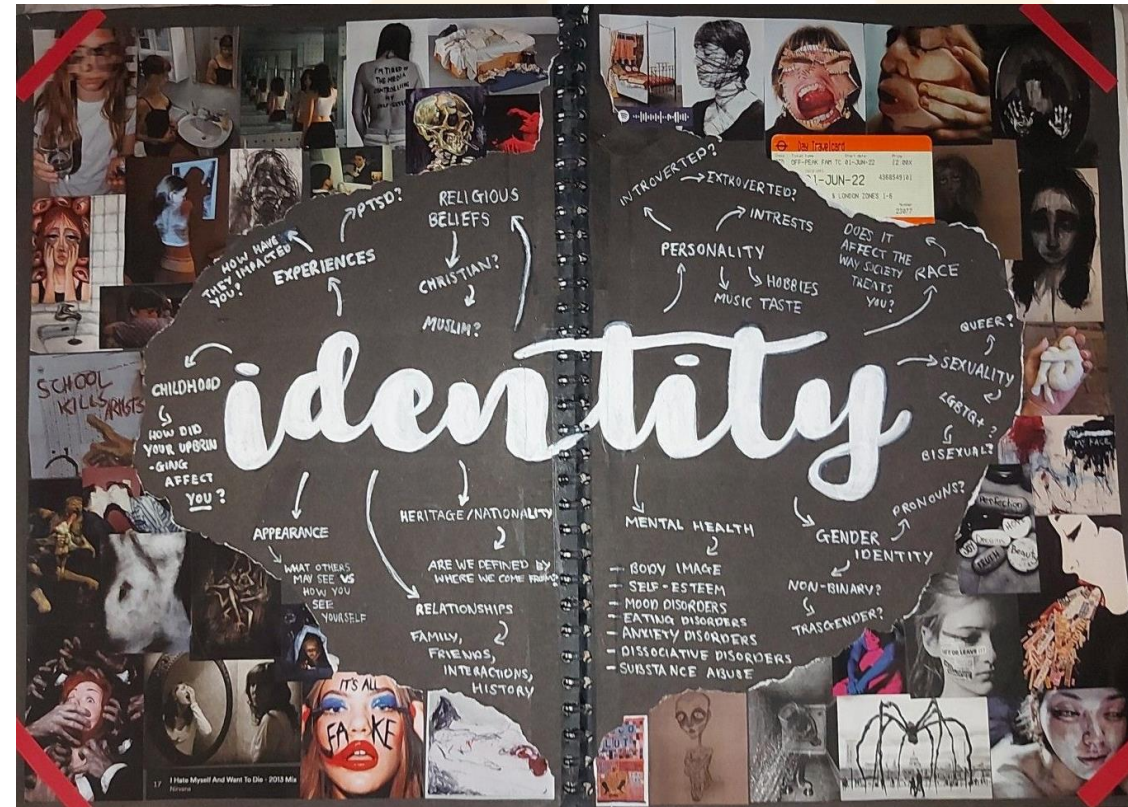




What is the purpose of a mood board?
