Objective



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- To develop an understanding of the work of others.
- To create a presentation showing understanding of an artist's techniques and processes.



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Literacy - artist page

Summarise:
Describe their work in 5 words.

Title:
Bold and large, matching the artists style.
(consider the colours in their work, if the work is detailed, patterns etc.)

Images:
Images of their work, which link to the theme of work you are doing.
(ensure they are the artist's work, and not someone working in their style)



Analysis:

- Describe the piece of artwork (what is happening, who is in it etc.)
- What is the theme of the work?
- What is the medium of the work? (painting, photograph, pencil work, print etc.)
- Is this piece realistic? If yes why, if no why?
- If the piece uses colour, what kind of colours do they use, does this change the emotion of the work?
- If the piece is tonal, do the tonal shades make an impact on the work?
- What do you think the message is behind the piece of work? (is there a meaning, is it telling a story?)
- What do you like about this piece of art?
- Why does this piece of work inspire you?
- What do you plan to do as a result of studying this artist?

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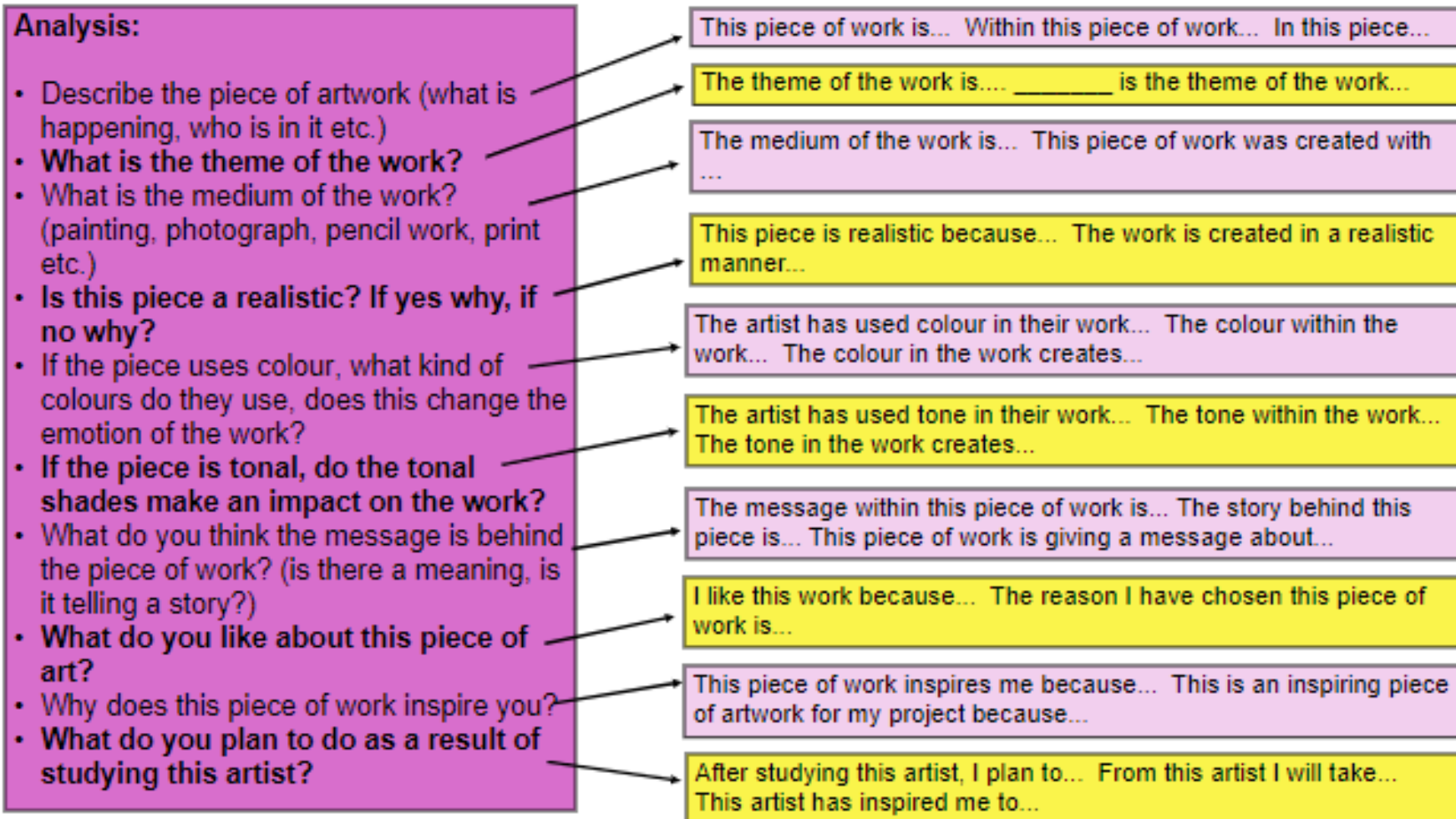
