

Incorrect – you must use primary source images in your book to gain a grade 5 and above.








- To experiment with the DSLR camera to create a selection of primary source photographs

Creating a contact sheet




Take a range of photographs – consider different angles, zooming in and out and different compositions

Add a contact sheet page into your PowerPoint showing all the photographs you have taken – good and bad.



IMG 9937 – balanced image with good composition


IMG 9941 – zoomed in on detailed focussed area
