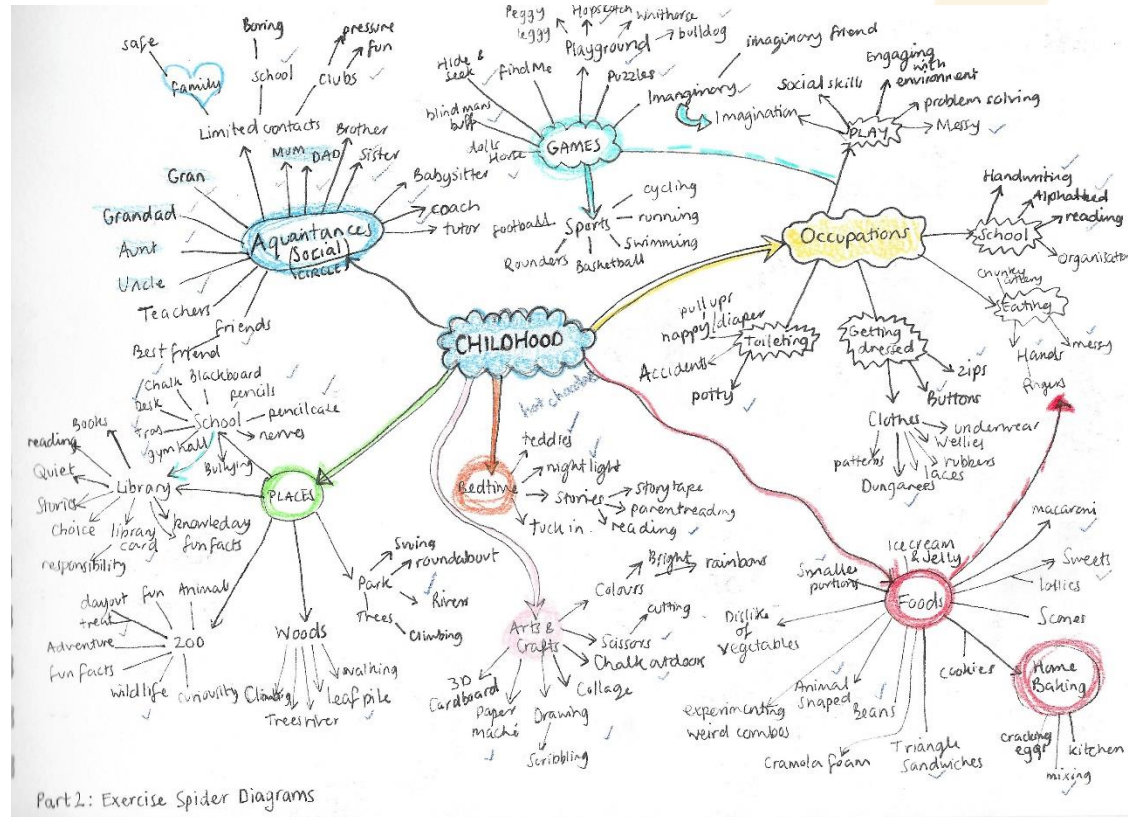
Creating a spider diagram
