Dear Parent /Carer,

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you and your child for your commitment to maintaining our school's high standards of uniform and presentation. Our uniform policy will be reinforced when pupils return to school on **Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March**. Please ensure any replacement items are purchased in advance.

We work with families to ensure that our uniform policy is affordable and easily accessible.

As a reminder, please can you support us to uphold the standards for the spring term of the academic school year.

- **School shoes must be worn and not trainers. Some examples are given below if your child requires new shoes for the spring term.**
- **Boots must be worn underneath trousers.**
- **Blazers must be worn at all times.**
- **Hooded jackets are not permitted to be worn underneath school blazers. Jackets/ coats of any kind are not permitted to be worn inside of the building.**
- **Jewellery will be confiscated if seen as stated in our uniform policy. Earrings are allowed but only small studs no bigger than 5mm.**
- **Trousers should be professional dress trousers with a button and zip fastening. Leggings are not permitted.**
- **False nails and eyelashes are not permitted as stated in our uniform policy. Please ensure these are removed.**

There is a link to Michael Sehgal and Sons Ltd below should you require any replacement items along with school shoe examples should you require replacements.

When your child arrives at school, they will be welcomed at our 'Checkpoint Challenge'. Each checkpoint will give your child a chance to prepare themselves for the day ahead. Our gates open at 8.30am ready for form time at 8.45am prompt. Please ensure your child is punctual to school each day.

Checkpoint 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Phones, electronic devices are removed, switched off and placed at the bottom of their school bag</li> <li>• Hoodies are removed/ tracksuit zip tops under blazers are removed</li> <li>• Any jewellery removed – we suggest that jewellery is not worn at all for school</li> </ul>
Checkpoint 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Uniform standards – blazer, tie, shirt tucked in, pleated knee length skirt, appropriate trousers, correct footwear</li> <li>• Removal of contraband (fizzy drinks, sweets, large share bag crisps etc)</li> </ul>
Checkpoint 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Opportunity to sign out an 'On Track Pack' which you child can use for their whole day of learning if they have forgotten their equipment (pencil case, pen, pencil, ruler, rubber)</li> <li>• When they leave school that day, they drop it back in the box on exit. If your child chooses to keep the pack, we will add a cost of £3.00 to their parent pay account</li> </ul>
