Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements made for the GCSE Results Day and to outline times for your child to collect their exam results. As you will be aware, GCSE results will be released on **Thursday 20th August 2026**.

1. Students are invited into school to collect their results face-to-face from 9:30am – 10:30am. Please arrive at school via Student Reception, adhering to the times to ensure that the handout of results goes smoothly.
2. If students are unable to collect their results in person, please email the Exams Officer hga-exams@consilium-at.com. Students will be asked to provide a letter, signed by the student, nominating a person to collect their results. The nominated person must produce photo identification to confirm they are permitted to collect - without this they will not be able to take the exam results.
3. If a student is unable to collect the results in person on the day, or nominate a person on their behalf, the results will be posted to their address via first class post on Thursday 20th August 2026. Please ensure school have your most up-to-date address if you have recently moved.
4. All students are required to complete a short Destination Form before they collect their exam results. This information is collected to fulfil the Local Authority's statutory requirement to track intended post-16 destinations and helps ensure that any student without a confirmed place for Year 12 or further education, employment or training can be identified and supported promptly. Students must not leave the results venue until this form has been completed.
5. If students have any queries regarding their Year 12 intended choices following their GCSE results, staff will be on hand to offer advice and guidance. Personal Development lead and Careers Education, Ms Bell, will be available in the Theatre along with representatives from Further Education.
6. Details about re-marks for exam papers are on the school website within the Key Information section.

We welcome students to take the opportunity to celebrate their achievements and will have a place for them to take photographs after they have received their results.

Results Day is also a good opportunity for students to return any remaining textbooks, revision guides, or uniform they may still have so there will be drop-off boxes at Student Reception.
